Overview

This website is a WordPress site, certain information is stored each time you visit. This information includes, but is not limited to: IP address, WordPress.com user ID (if logged in), WordPress.com username (if logged in), user agent, visiting URL, referring URL, timestamp of event, browser language, country code. This data is anonymized, which means that there is no way to identify a specific user. Instead, the data is available in a general way that shows trends and patterns. For example, it is possible to identify the number of visits to a particular page, but not individual users who visited it.
